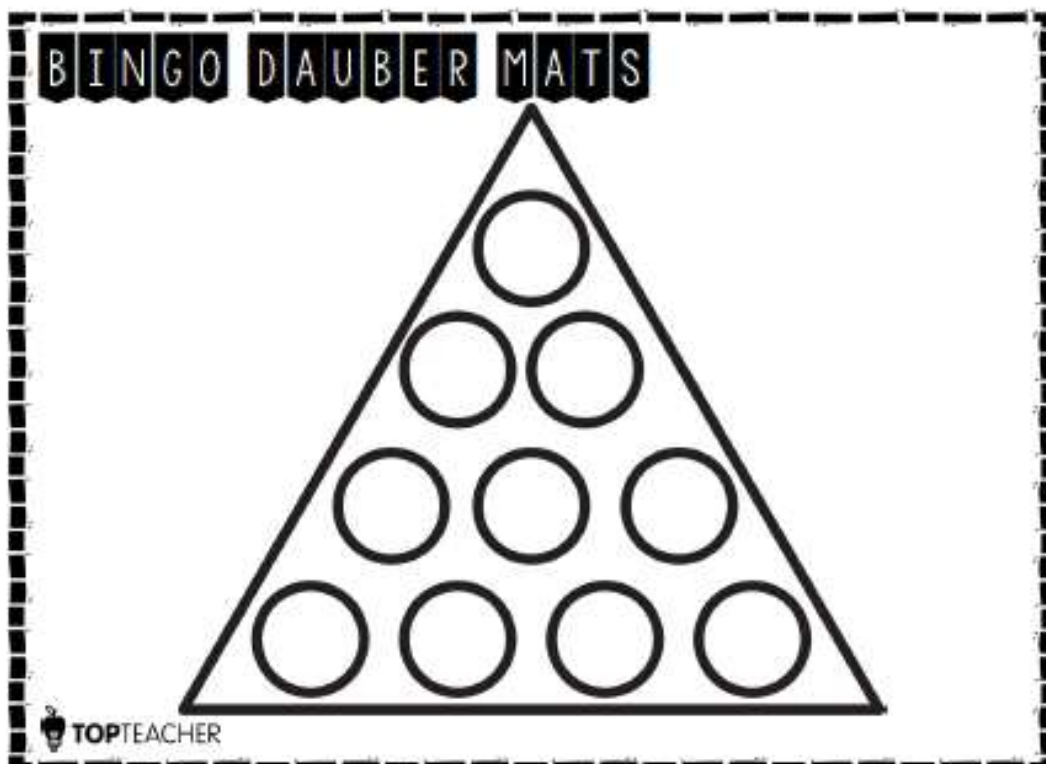
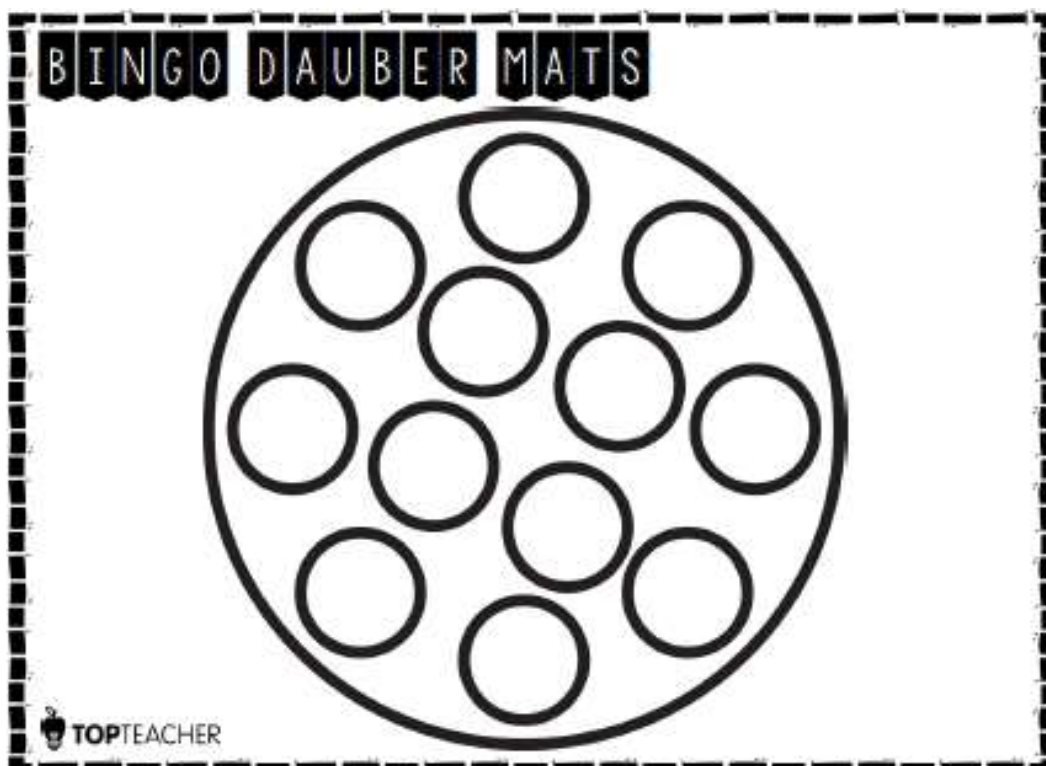

**You will need:**

**\*Kitchen tongs or tweezers \*small objects such as pom poms, buttons or marbles**

- 1. Pick up one pom pom with the tongs and place it on a circle in one of the shapes.**
- 2. Continue to pick up one pom pom at a time until you have covered all of the small circles inside each shape.**

**Be sure to use your thumb and index finger (the first finger) to hold the tongs. We call these our power fingers and we need them strong to be good at drawing and writing.**
